- Maintenance work since 2012 has been limited to small repairs and essentials ONLY due to funding

Drainage Board <u>PROPOSED</u> TOTAL ASSESSMENT: \$33,176.44

Proposed to stop collection when balance equals or exceeds four (4) times the annual collection amount (\$33,176.44 x 4 = \$132,705.76). Collection would begin again when balance falls below four (4) year collection amount.

Projected/Estimated average yearly maintenance cost: \$20,000

Tile repair, Tile replacement, Catch basin installation and repair, outlet protection, Brush clearing, Excavation of the open ditch, Bank stabilization, Brush control/mowing, Herbicide application, Seeding, DNR/Army Corp.
