RECONSTRUCTION REPORT FOR THE SILVEUS DRAIN

(ORIGINALLY KNOWN AS ARM #1 OF THE SYLVESTER BARBER DRAIN AND A PORTION OF THE MAIN #208 AS APPROVED IN 1898. REF. COMMISSIONER'S DITCH RECORD BOOK 5 PAGES 569-580)
-Seward Township, Kosciusko County, Indiana-

The Kosciusko County Drainage Board has instructed me to prepare a reconstruction report for the <u>Silveus Drain</u>. This proposed reconstruction begins where the tile Main empties into the open ditch (in the SE1/4 of Sec. 9-T30N-R5E) and ends where Arm #1 crosses the W. line of the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 of Sec. 9-T30N-R5E.

This proposed reconstruction is designed to improve and provide drainage for the 602.92 acre watershed area.

It is the County Surveyor's opinion that this drain is in need of reconstruction.

There are two drainage areas that are a part of this proposed reconstruction project. Area #1 consist of only those lands affected by Arm #1 in its entirety. Area #2 consists of those lands affected by only the Main within the proposed reconstruction area. Since both areas are affected by the proposed 510' of Main Ditch reconstruction, all landowners within both areas ("Area 1" and "Area 2" = 602.92 acres) would share that cost. Only those landowners within the shed area of Arm #1 ("Area 1" = 351.32 acres) would share the cost of reconstruction on that arm.

The current/existing pipe size within the project area are 12" (Arm #1) and 24" (Main).

The proposed reconstruction project consists of approx:

Main: 510' of 30" double-walled plastic tile (including installation)

Bedded in stone through deep cuts

T and/or Y including where Arm #1 meets the Main

Overburden removal

Removal of old tile

Hookup of all laterals

Incidentals (approx. 10%)

TOTAL ESTIMATE: \$78,917

If approved, the Surveyor's Office would have a starting date of fall 2019 after harvest.

A list of all affected landowners is made a part of this report. The shed map, schedule of assessment for each tract of land (based on benefitted acres) and plan profile is also a part of this report. All are available for review in the office of the Kosciusko County Surveyor.
